Learn to plan and control the flow of goods and information in a supply chain by using IT-based analytics. In the Logistics and Supply Chain Management programme, you will gain skills that will enable you to design a highly efficient strategy for supply chain management that can be applied to a diverse range of businesses.

MAKING IT WORK

In the programme you will acquire nuanced analytical skills with which to systematically and creatively solve a range of complex logistical problems. You will also develop a strong fundamental understanding of the complexities and breakdown of the value chain.

Logistics and supply chain management is a very demanding programme that calls for active student participation, communication, and strong time-management skills.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

You are encouraged to do an internship during your degree – and AU supports its students by giving them an opportunity to do this. Companies like Vestas, Arla, Terma and Siemens regularly provide projects for students on the programme, and nearly all students write their thesis for a company. Generally, students work with companies that face challenging logistics problems which they want students to help them solve. Previous collaborative projects by Logistics and Supply Chain Management students have been conducted with the supplier relationship management

division at LEGO, production planning by SAP at Danish Crown, inventory control at TDC, warehouse management at Arla, forecasting at Danfoss, and location of distribution centres at Bauhaus.

STUDENT LIFE

Aarhus BSS hosts a rich and varied programme of activities for you as a student, both study-related and social. Our many student associations host events ranging from lectures and company events to career days and sports days, Friday bars and celebrations, so there is plenty of scope for meeting and networking with like-minded people, discovering new areas of academic interest, and socialising with fellow students. In addition, SULO, the Logistics and SCM programme's own student association, arranges company visits, study trips and social events for logistics students.

CAREERS

Graduates with the MSc in Logistics and Supply Chain Management have found jobs analysing logistical performance or implementing new logistical solutions. They may start under the supervision of experienced colleagues and rapidly progress to managerial and executive roles. AU's big-picture, analytical approach to logistics and supply chain management allows our graduates to be versatile in their future careers and to find success across a variety of sectors. Previous graduates have worked as project managers, economists, analysts, and consultants.
